

WHAT IS SUPRELORIN® 4.7 mg?

Suprelorin® 4.7 mg is a temporary contraceptive implant for male dogs, administered by your veterinarian.

It is inserted under the skin between your dog's shoulders.

It prevents testosterone and sperm production.

There is no need for anaesthetic or surgery.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

After implant placement, an active ingredient is steadily released preventing the production of testosterone.

Testosterone is essential for sperm production and reproduction in the male.

It takes around 6 weeks for the dog to become completely infertile due to remnant sperm stored in the reproductive tract.

Once infertile, sperm production is prevented for at least 6 months. Once the implant wears off the dog's fertility will gradually return.*

What will you see?

- Loss of interest in bitches.
- Loss of ability to ejaculate.
- Smaller testicles.

These are all temporary and will all return to normal as the active wears off.

Safety

To ensure continued infertility it is recommended to place an implant every 6 months.

*Discuss with your veterinarian prior to use in a breeding dog. In some dogs infertility can last longer than 6 months.

- Test the behavioural response to lowered testosterone.
- For the benefit of reproduction control now, with the option to breed in future*.
